While we are doing everything in our power to ensure the integrity and security of your financial data, it is essential that you understand the following:

- You **MUST** maintain paper copies and backup documentation of all receipts, invoices, and financial records, downloading all Financial reports and the cash book, bank book, income book and expense book monthly.
- Do **NOT** discard any original financial documentation in reliance on the app
- Technology can sometimes fail—protecting yourself with complete backup records is essential to your organization's financial accountability

While we work diligently to prevent any data loss or technical issues, you assume responsibility for maintaining comprehensive documentation outside of Lychee.

5. Limitation of Liability

During the onboarding process, you will acknowledge that Accountable Partners and Lychee are not liable for any loss of data, financial discrepancies, or other issues that may arise from use of the platform. This is beta software under active development, and while we strive for excellence, you participate with the understanding that the platform is being refined and perfected.

6. Applicable Parties

This agreement applies to both donor partners who are providing Lychee subscriptions to community-based organizations, and to the community-based organizations themselves who are using the platform. All parties agree to the terms outlined above.
